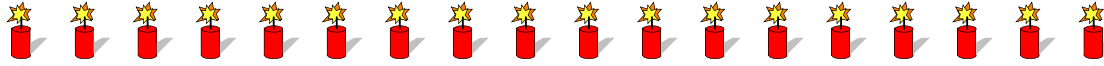
From The Trustees

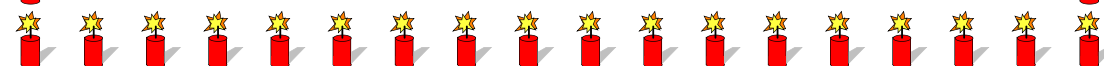


From Your Madam President...
